This itinerary contains the key information about the 2013 Film Club trip to Paris.

The primary purpose of this trip is to attend the screening of our film, "Unspoken" as part of the film-making programme established by the Cinémathèque Française in Paris called 'Le Cinéma, cent ans de jeunesse' (Cinema, 100 years young). Accommodation:

Perfect Hostel, 39 Rue Rodier, Paris 75009.

Incidental Costs:

The accommodation, transport, breakfasts and lunch at the Cinémathèque screening are provided, however the students will still need to bring some Euro currency to pay for evening food, one lunch and transport on the Paris Metro. This extra cash which will allow the boys to make independent decisions about food need not exceed **50.00 Euros**.

Tickets, belongings and passports:

The students will need to carry their own passports and are advised to avoid carrying valuable items. Travelling as a group in Paris will involve some extended periods of walking, sometimes with luggage, so our advice to is for the boys to travel light.
